

## Event Rules

1. Three-person teams (gender mixed or matched), with a (total-team average) cap of 570.

2. Use High USBC average for last season. If none, then from Spring or Summer (21 games or more). If none, then current season prior to Oct 01. \*Sports League averages will be adjusted.

3. Averages will be used only for the first game, placing the two highest average teams against each other, then the next two highest average teams opposed, etc.

4. When registering, designate any team player as "A", "B", or "C" and each will bowl in that position throughout the competition. "A" being lead off, "C" being anchor.

5. "A" will compete against "A" of the opposing team, "B" against "B," etc. There will be one point awarded for the higher game between each two opposing bowlers and two points awarded for higher team score. A total of five points is therefore achievable for each game.

6. There will be one bonus point for each 235 or above game and two bonus points for each 255 or above game.

7. The two teams with the highest point score will always oppose one another, with the others following. If there are ties for position points, the team with the highest accumulative pin fall will be placed first. Leading teams will bowl across the house with the others following as position dictates. This may mean that a team remains on the same lane for more than one game, or may be matched up against the same team more than once.
